

# Massachusetts

The proposed \$1.05 billion reduction in Medicare Part A skilled nursing facility expenditures on a nationwide level has a substantial impact on the local, state, and national economies. The estimated economic impact for Massachusetts is a reduction of \$63,729,605 in business activity, a reduction of \$33,021,646 in labor income, and a loss of 787 jobs.

The estimated economic impact for Massachusetts Congressional District 1 is a reduction of \$4,925,550 in business activity, a reduction of \$2,625,855 in labor income, and a loss of 67 jobs.
