

Michigan

The proposed \$1.05 billion reduction in Medicare Part A skilled nursing facility expenditures on a nationwide level has a substantial impact on the local, state, and national economies. The estimated economic impact for Michigan is a reduction of \$57,635,738 in business activity, a reduction of \$28,396,262 in labor income, and a loss of 910 jobs.
