The proposed \$1.05 billion reduction in Medicare Part A skilled nursing facility expenditures on a nationwide level has a substantial impact on the local, state, and national economies. The estimated economic impact for North Carolina is a reduction of \$48,272,816 in business activity, a reduction of \$23,400,115 in labor income, and a loss of 826 jobs.
