

Ohio

The proposed \$1.05 billion reduction in Medicare Part A skilled nursing facility expenditures on a nationwide level has a substantial impact on the local, state, and national economies. The estimated economic impact for Ohio is a reduction of \$99,032,887 in business activity, a reduction of \$48,707,168 in labor income, and a loss of 1,610 jobs.
