

Virginia

The proposed \$1.05 billion reduction in Medicare Part A skilled nursing facility expenditures on a nationwide level has a substantial impact on the local, state, and national economies. The estimated economic impact for Virginia is a reduction of \$41,012,740 in business activity, a reduction of \$20,479,074 in labor income, and a loss of 600 jobs.

Total Impact is the sum of the direct, indirect, and induced effects.

Labor Income is the sum of employee compensation and proprietary income.
