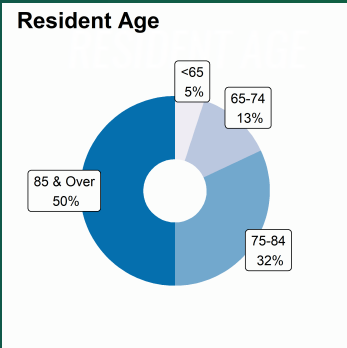
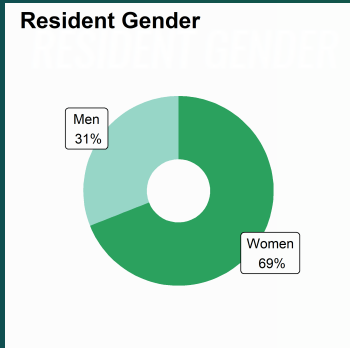

- 60%** Need Help Bathing
- 66%** Need Help Walking
