

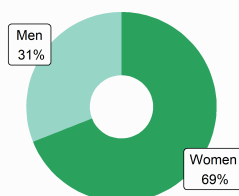

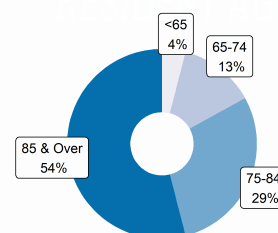

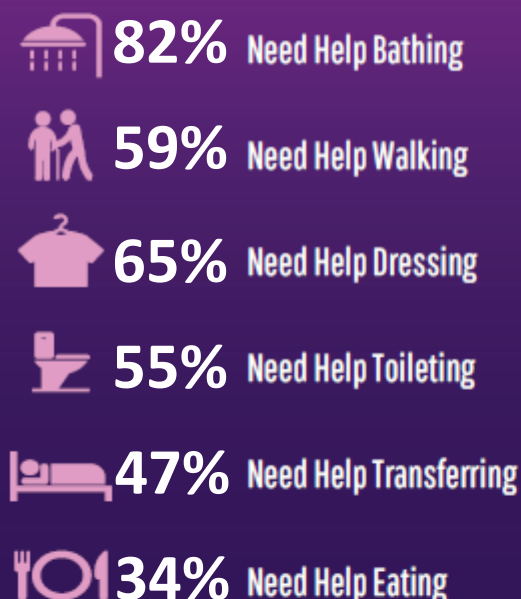
Resident Gender
