

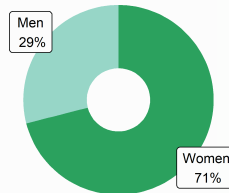

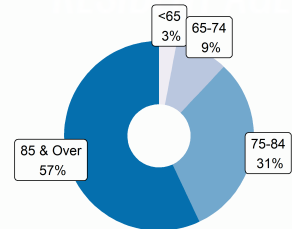

Resident Gender



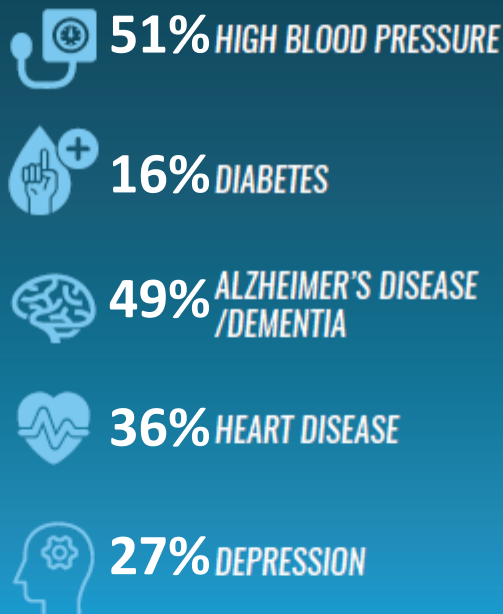
Resident Age
