Station Implementation Tips - Laundry and Linen

1. Set-Up

- a. Gather all:
 - Supplies- various sized gloves and gowns, alcohol-based hand rub/hand sanitizer, various types of linen, trash bags, or other containers for nursing staff to put soiled linens in, large container to put bags of soiled linens in, bed
 - b. Teaching materials- handouts, competency checklists, quiz copies
- 2. Provide a short overview of why safe laundry and linen handling is important
- 3. Demonstrate how to properly handle contaminated linens
- 4. Perform handling of contaminated linen competency validation with each staff member and document results on competency checklist.
 - a. Consider setting up a room simulation have staff remove contaminated linens from the bed and carry it to a large container to put them in. Then have staff make up the bed with clean linens.
 - Vary the scenarios say bed linen soiled with feces, or resident is on Contact precautions, have "soiled" linen on floor or on top of trash can
 - b. If staff member did not successfully complete the competency:
 - i. Provide and document remedial education
 - ii. Repeat competency validation and document results
 - c. Administer linen handling quiz-keep completed quizzes in education file
