Medicare Advantage Improvement Act of 2026

S. 4384 / H.R. 8375

More than 35 million seniors — over half of Medicare beneficiaries — are enrolled in Medicare Advantage (MA). This bipartisan, bicameral bill addresses critical issues within Medicare Advantage.

Improving Access to Medicare Coverage Act

S. 4641 / H.R. 3954

This bill is a bipartisan, bicameral, patient-centered solution supported by a broad coalition of provider, physician, aging, and advocacy organizations.

STRENGTHENING THE ASSISTED LIVING & SKILLED NURSING WORKFORCE

America is facing a significant long term care workforce shortage. By 2033, the U.S. will need an additional 660,000 workers across nursing and other key caregiving roles to meet demand.

Ensuring Seniors' Access to Quality Care Act (S. 4467/H.R. 7096): Allows facilities to restart in-house training programs after deficiencies are corrected, helping rebuild workforce training capacity and expand access to caregivers.

Caring for Seniors Act (H.R. 300): Invest in workforce development programs specifically focused on caring for older adults, helping assisted providers recruit and prepare the next generation of caregivers.

Healthcare Workforce Resilience Act (S. 2795/H.R. 5283): Recaptures unused visas for healthcare providers and their families, strengthening the long-term care workforce pipeline.

Train More Nurses Act (S. 547/H.R. 5052): Reviews federal nursing grant programs and identifies ways to expand nursing faculty, especially in underserved communities where workforce needs are amplified.
