




BLS NOVEMBER JOBS REPORT: NURSING HOMES

Nursing Homes have lost 234,000 employees since start of pandemic

According to the latest Bureau of Labor Statistics report, the nursing home industry has lost 234,000 employees since the start of pandemic and another 8,000 employees in the last month.

NURSING HOMES WORST IMPACTED INDUSTRY OF HEALTH CARE SECTOR

While hospitals, physicians' offices, outpatient care centers and other health care facilities have reached or surpassed pre-pandemic staffing levels, nursing homes are still experiencing substantial job losses according to the latest November employment data from the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS).
