


Long Term Care Jobs Report May 2023

Nursing homes are facing a historic labor crisis brought on by the pandemic.








The nursing home workforce is at levels not seen since 1995.








Nursing homes added an average of 4,500 jobs per month over the last 12 months. At the current pace, nursing homes will not return to pre-pandemic levels until late 2026.














LONG TERM CARE: WORST IMPACTED THAN ANY OTHER HEALTH CARE SECTOR
