




## Long Term Care Jobs Report January 2023

Looking at data from the federal government, nursing homes are still facing historic job losses while other health care industries have mostly rebounded to pre-pandemic levels.




# Nursing homes have lost more than 200,000 workers over the course of the pandemic.






### The nursing home workforce is at levels not seen since 1994.






#### Nursing homes added an average of 3,700 jobs per month over the last 9 months. At the current pace, nursing homes would not return to pre-pandemic levels until 2027.













#### LONG TERM CARE: WORST IMPACTED THAN ANY OTHER HEALTH CARE SECTOR
