That's why an RSV vaccine is recommended for anyone:



Age 75 or older



Ages 60-74 with conditions such as heart or lung disease, obesity, or diabetes



Age 60 or older in a nursing home



32-36 weeks pregnant during RSV season (September 1-January 31) to protect
