GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The role of the AHCA/NCAL National Quality Award Volunteer Examiner is extremely important to the program. Examiners are a vital part of the Quality Award workforce, contributing their time and expertise to the fulfillment of the programs key work processes, mission and core competencies. Once selected to serve, the program relies on every Examiner to fulfill their commitment.

There are significant benefits to serving as an Examiner, including professional development, networking, education, and much more. Serving as an Examiner is a significant accomplishment as it is intellectually challenging and requires a substantial time commitment. Individuals who apply as an Examiner must be prepared to satisfy the full commitment.

REQUIRED SKILLS

For all Examiner roles, the program looks for individuals that exhibit the following characteristics:

- Passion for continuous quality improvement
- Willingness to learn and take feedback
- Adaptability
- Ability to work effectively in a team environment
- Strong analytical skills
- Attention to detail
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Time management skills
- Ability to meet deadlines and work independently

Experience required to apply

Silver Examiner

- Individuals completely new to the Baldrige criteria
- Award recipients (Bronze, Silver or Gold) without Examiner experience
- Returning Silver Examiners not participating as team leaders

Silver Team Lead

- Returning Silver Examiners with 2+ years of experience
- Returning Silver Team Leaders

Gold Examiner

- Individuals who have served as Examiners or Judges for other Baldrige-based programs
- Returning Gold Examiners not participating as team leaders
- Returning Silver Examiners with 2+ years of experience

Gold Team Lead

- Returning Gold Examiners with 2+ years of experience
- Returning Gold Team Leaders
