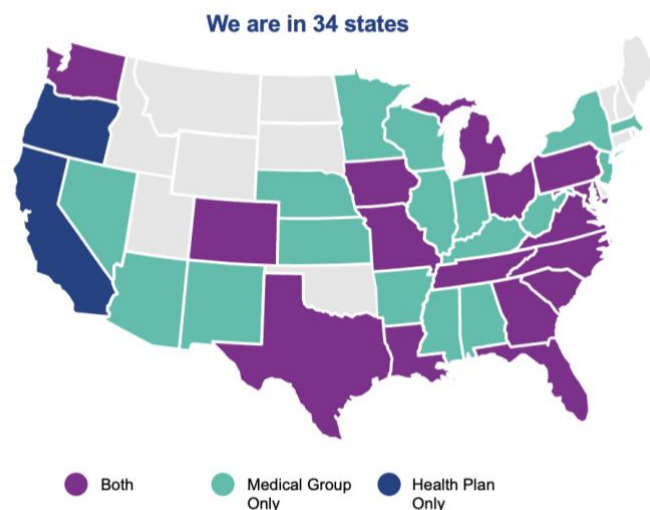




Redefining Care for Senior Housing Residents
