Accurate coding in the new Patient Driven Payment Model (PDPM) is essential!

Act now to ensure that your staff are proficient and ready.

The Patient Driven Payment Model (PDPM) takes effect on October 1, 2019 and the Resource Utilization Groups (RUGs) system ends. PDPM relies on rapid, accurate patient assessment and diagnosis on the MDS and ICD-10 coding to determine payments for each patient. Incorrect or insufficient coding can significantly impact the payment rate for each patient.

To assist in the building of coding proficiency, AHCA has partnered with the American Health Information Management Association (AHIMA) to offer two targeted on-line trainings.

AHCA/AHIMA ICD-10 Training for PDPM — Coder

This in-depth course features 7 modules covering coding and clinical document improvement (CDI). SNF coders will learn ICD-10-CM coding guidelines, CDI program implementation, and best practices for transitioning to PDPM. (16 CNEs for nurses and 16 AHIMA CE upon completion)
